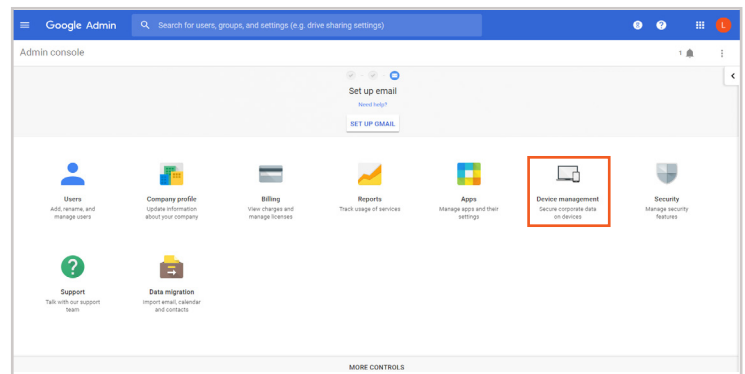


GOOGLE ADMIN CHROME EXTENSION MANAGEMENT

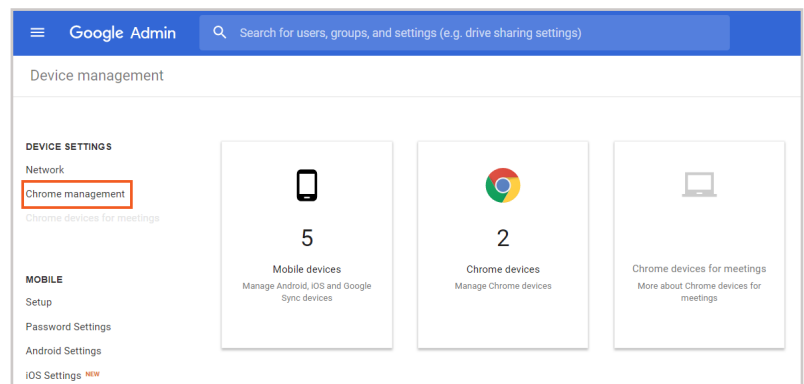
Enable users to view and access content from Gale's *Opposing Viewpoints In Context* within Google results. Follow the steps below to install the chrome extension (beta) to shared computers via the Google Admin Tool.

STEP ONE: Login to your Google admin account via <http://admin.google.com>

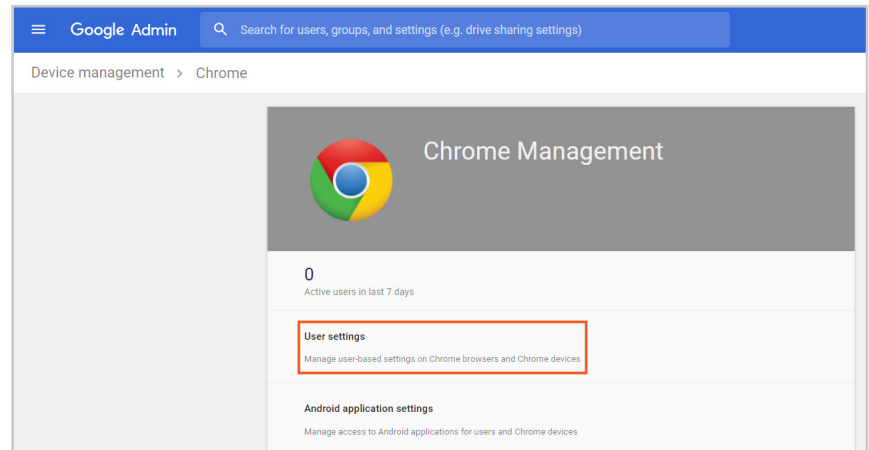
STEP TWO: In the Admin console, select **Device Management**



STEP THREE: Select **Chrome Management**



STEP FOUR: Select **User Settings**

STEP FIVE: Under Apps and Extensions section > **Force-installed Apps and Extensions**, select the **Managed force-installed apps** link

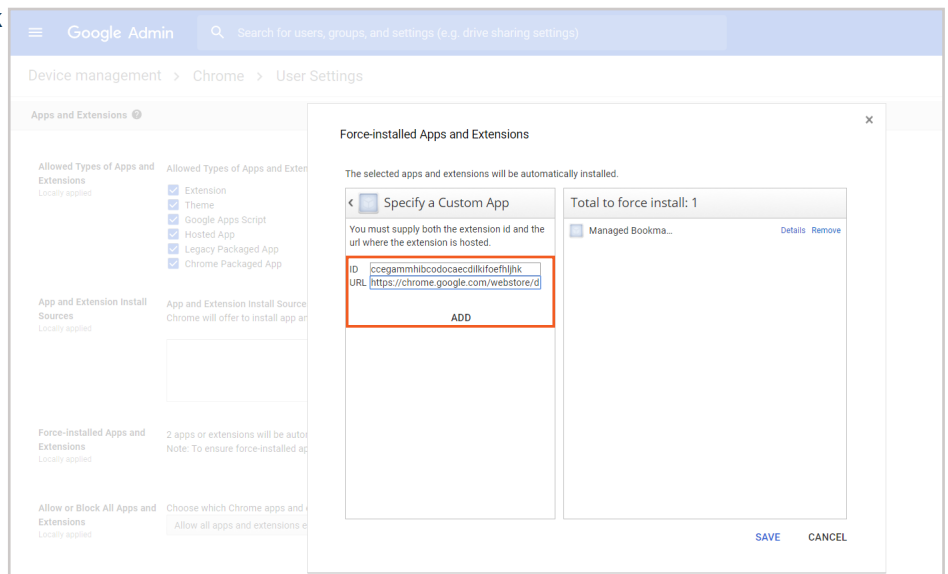

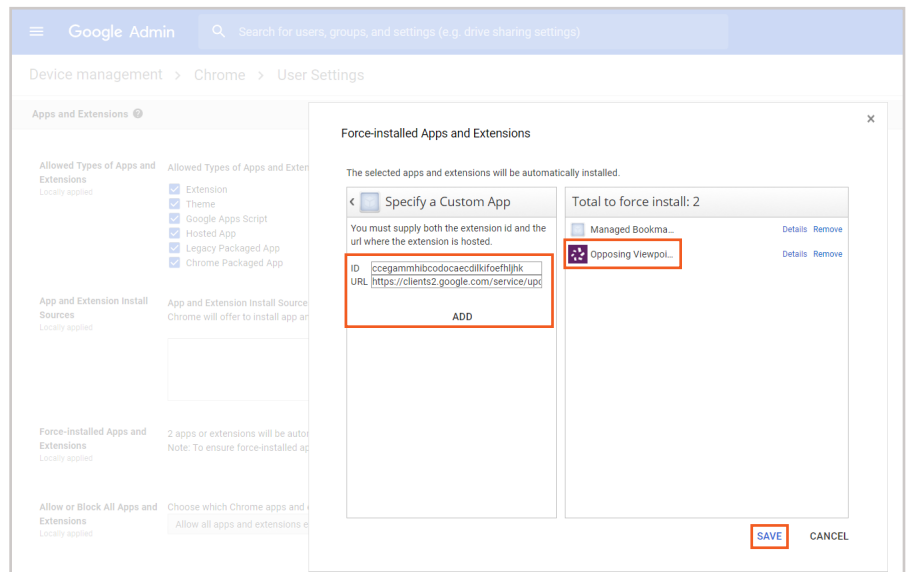

STEP EIGHT: Select **ADD** to see the Opposing Viewpoints icon then click **SAVE**



SETUP THE CONFIGURATION POLICY

STEP TEN: Create and upload a configuration policy .txt file

STEP ELEVEN: Location name = the name that will appear at the top of the Chrome Extension

STEP TWELVE: Location ID and Password to access your library's database.

Example of .txt configuration file for Chrome OS:

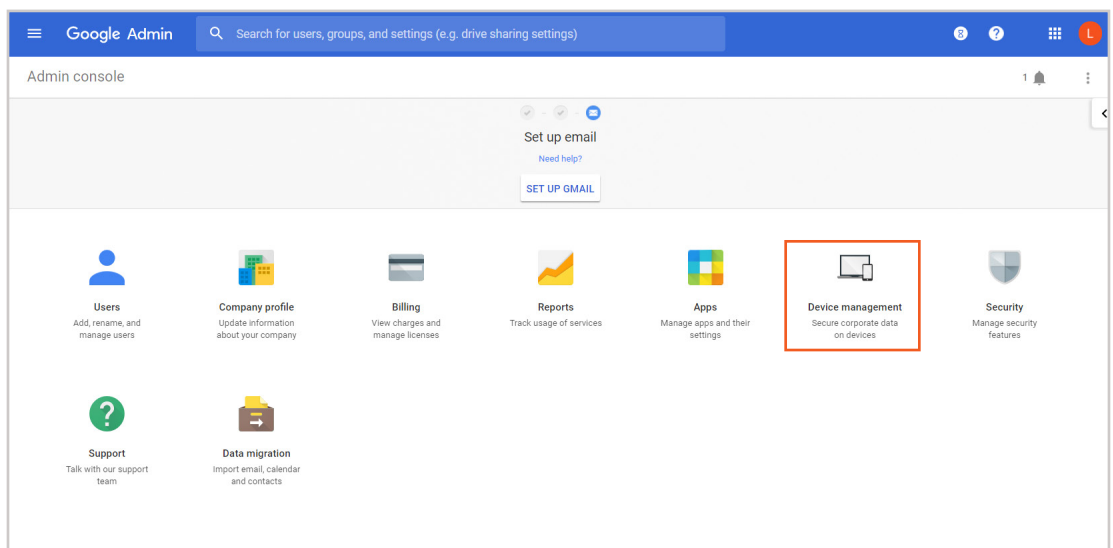

For Linux users, use the policy configuration by placing the following file in `/etc/opt/chrome/policies/managed/policies.json`:

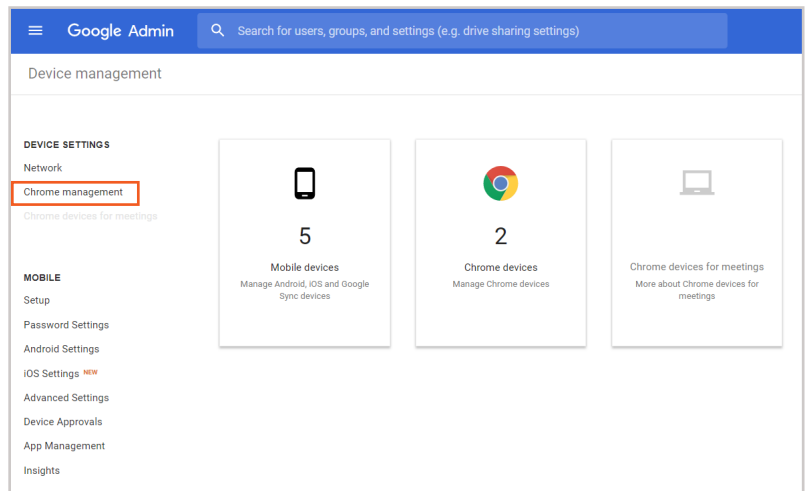

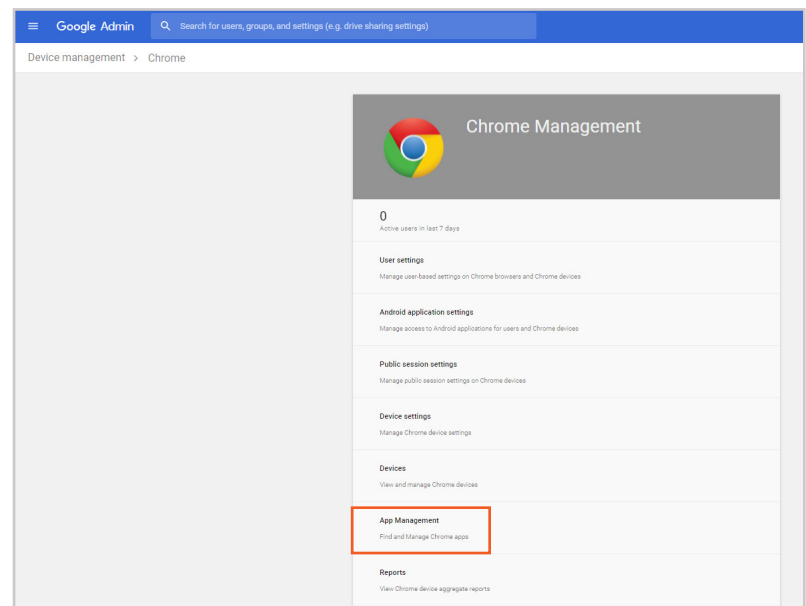
STEP THIRTEEN: Select Device Management



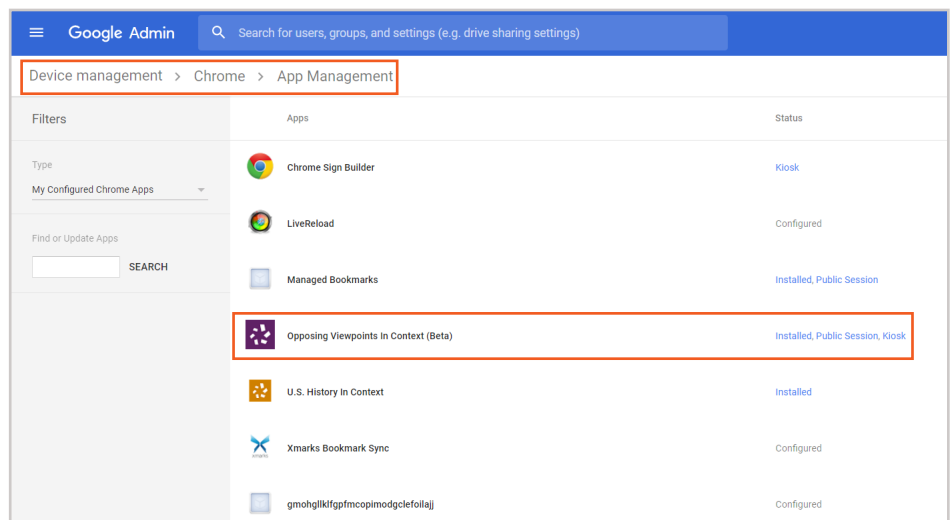
STEP FOURTEEN: Select Chrome Management



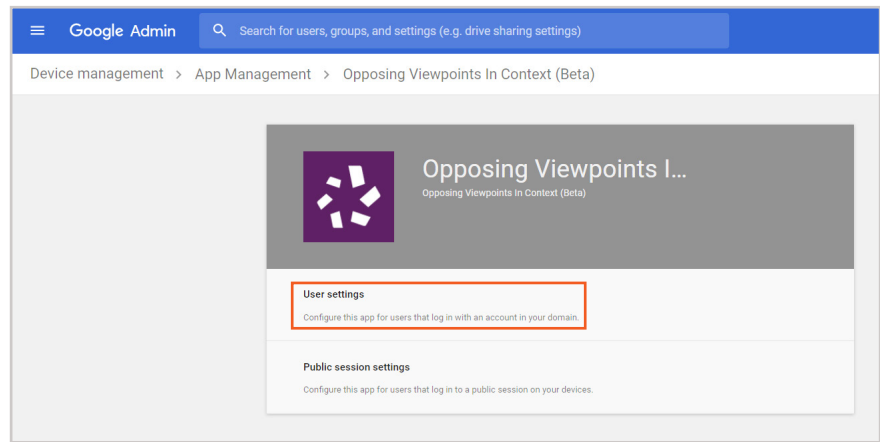
STEP FIFTEEN: Select App Management



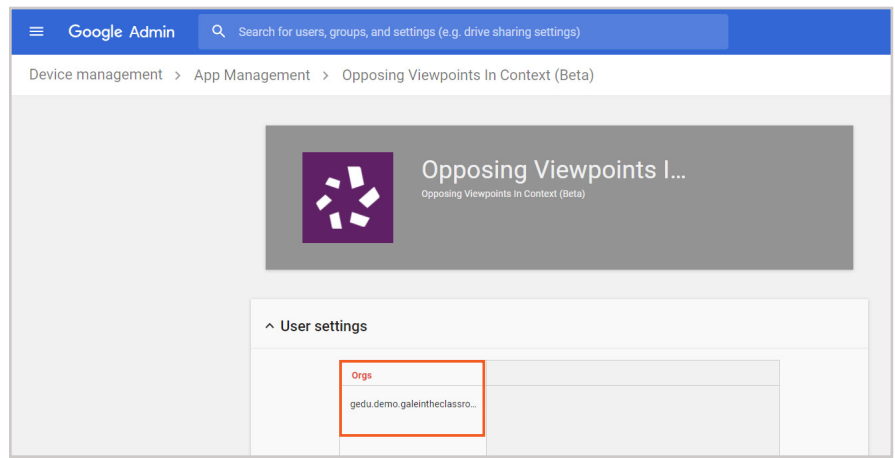
STEP SIXTEEN: Select extension *Opposing Viewpoints In Context (Beta)*



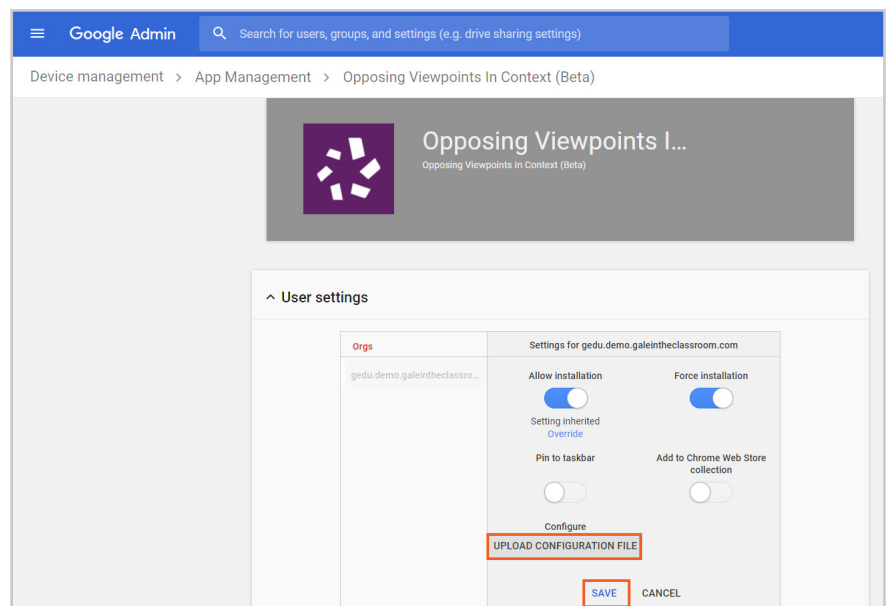
STEP SEVENTEEN: Select **User settings**

STEP NINETEEN: Upload Configuration File and Select **Save**
