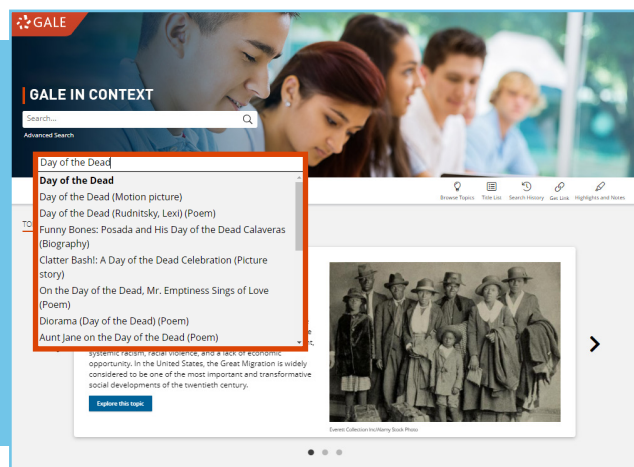

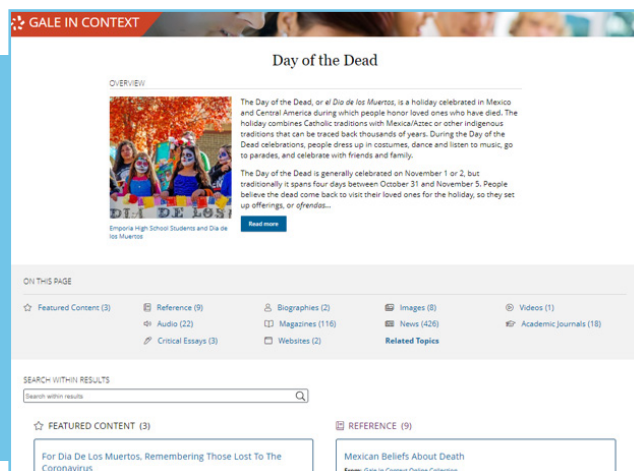
BASIC SEARCH

1. Navigate to the **Basic Search** at the top of the page.
2. Type “Day of the Dead”.
3. Select the bolded predictive text option to be directed to the Day of the Dead **Topic Page**.
4. The **Topic Page** provides a clean and organized starting point for your researchers.



TOPIC PAGE

1. Select the **Overview** to read an introductory article.
2. Scroll down to find different **Content Buckets** to find reference materials, multimedia content, biographies, or news reports.
3. Navigate to the bottom of the page to see **Related Topics** to further research.



TOPIC FINDER

1. Navigate to the **Advanced Search** next to the **Basic Search** bar.
2. Select **Topic Finder** from the gray bar at the top of the page.
3. Search for Day of the Dead to find related topics and content in an interactive format.
