STEP THREE:

Utilize Gale's tools including Highlights and Notes, Google/Microsoft Integration, Listen, and Translate to boost learning and research skills.

NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC KIDS

STEP ONE:

Navigate to the Search bar on the homepage. Run a basic search for Women.

STEP TWO:

Scroll down to the Books section of the results page and select View All.

STEP THREE:

Filter to narrow results and find topics of interest.

STEP FOUR:

Select a title to read the full eBook. Utilize the Filter bar on the right-hand side to explore specific book sections or find related subjects.

APPLY THE CONTENT
