
GALE PAGES QUICK TIPS: CREATING PAGES

Create pages to organize your resources and direct individuals to the best content for them. With just a few clicks your library can have a simple, organized web page perfect for all user types.


ACCESS THE PAGES SECTION

- Sign into the Gale Pages Studio using your Gale Admin credentials. For assistance, contact Gale Technical Support at 1-800-877-4253.
- Select Pages in the tool bar at the top of the screen.
- You will be launched into the Pages section, where you can edit your current pages and create new ones.




CREATE A PAGE

- While in the Pages section, select Add Page.
- Choose which page type suits your needs, you can highlight resources, display eBooks, utilize an HTML editor, and more.
- After you make your page type selection, title
 it and include a Subjects Menu to help your
 users narrow down to a topic.



EDIT YOUR PAGE

- Select a Page to edit.
- Utilize the Page Settings option to change the general information of the page, including the name, colors, header, and tab information.
- Select Resource Setup to choose how to display your resources, including options to change subjects, icons, and Gale Power Search.
- Use the Resources, Boxes, and Embed options to add specific content to your page.
 These boxes allow you to select different resources, and add supplemental content.
