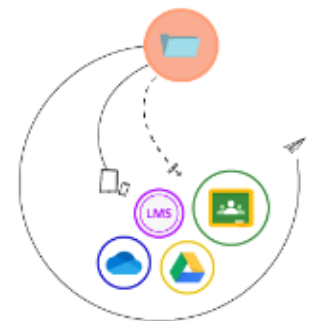
## **FIND**
