

# A Scholarly Literature Review: Psychological Perspectives on Contemporary Societal Issues

# **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

This project tasks students with exploring the psychological impact of a current event, such as the COVID-19 pandemic, on mental health. They will conduct a literature review using <a href="OneFile: Psychology">OneFile: Psychology</a> or <a href="Academic OneFile">Academic OneFile</a>, two reputable databases, to analyze and synthesize peer-reviewed studies. This project aims to develop students' research skills, critical thinking abilities, and understanding of psychological factors in real-world contexts, while utilizing a comprehensive resource to access high-quality scholarly articles. They will then be asked to present their findings and reflect on the project as a whole.

Linked in this instructor guide are editable documents and slide decks that you can download, and restructure as needed. Please feel free to adapt this content to fit the needs of your coursework.

# **LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

- Strengthen analysis skills through the completion of a literature review
- Develop critical thinking skills by identifying the correlation between a current event and its psychological impacts
- Demonstrate an understanding of how psychological factors influence behavior and decisionmaking in real-world contexts

## **BRIDGE-IN**

Before beginning this project, students should know how to find trustworthy, academic articles, how to use search terms effectively to locate relevant content and have a basic understanding of standard methodology in psychology research.

This project is a good fit for placement towards the end of the semester as a culminating assignment that integrates and applies the various concepts and skills covered throughout the course. Alternatively, it could be introduced earlier in the semester as a hands-on research assignment to engage students in finding and evaluating peer-reviewed studies, serving as a practical application of research skills learned in the early stages of the course and providing a foundation for further exploration of psychological topics throughout the semester
