Step 1: On the home page, locate the Basic Search Bar at the top of the page on the left.

Step 2: Type in what you would like to search. When searching for an answer you never want to put the entire question in the basic search bar. Pick one or two terms from the question instead to get better results. For this question, a good search would be "Abraham Lincoln" since we are looking for information about his life.

Step 3: Once you have gotten to the results page for Abraham Lincoln, you will see the "Biography" content type and can click on any of those results to find the year he was born.

Step 3: When searching for information about a topic that is NOT a person, a good place to start is clicking the "Read More" button or clicking on a piece of content in the "Reference" content type. These will give you basic information about a topic like a "Biography" would about a person.

If you are ever unsure what terms to search in the **Basic Search Bar**, you can also use **Topic Page** browsing to find this answer.

Step 1: On the home page, scroll down to view the available starting **Topics**. Select the one your question is related to. For this question, the Constitution would be related to government so you would select the "**Government**" Topic.

Step 2: Narrow your results by selecting the more specific Topic Page within the Government category. You would select "Constitution" to get all related content about the U.S. Constitution

Step 3: From here, you can either "Read More" or use a piece in the "Reference" content bucket to find your answer.
