Excel Adult High School Success Coaches are available for students to contact with questions or issues. They can also assist with general encouragement/motivation, special-case scenarios, and course and career planning. To contact a Success Coach, students can call or text (952) 465-3700.

LIBRARY COMMUNICATION:

- Success Coaches log notes under the Notes tab accessible from a student's profile, where you can add notes as well. Students are unable to view these notes.
- For questions regarding students, library Program Managers are encouraged to reach out to Jodi Alama and Nancy Hoff (jalama@excelhighschool.com & nhoff@excelhighschool.com).

STUDENT SUPPORT:

- Students receive an encouraging email from a Success Coach at 31 days, 60 days, 90 days, 6 months, and 1 year of enrollment.
- At 30 days and 60 days of inactivity, a Success Coach will reach out with an email/phone call to check in with the student.
- If a student hasn't logged in for 60+ days, they'll be put on an Attendance Hold. To have this hold removed, they will need to contact a Success Coach. Success Coaches take this opportunity to discuss the importance of logging in often.
- If a student calls the Success Coach team, they'll be connected with one of six coaches. If a student has formed a relationship with a coach, they may request that coach specifically.

LIBRARY TIPS:

- While Success Coaches are there to help students, the most successful students have support from both Success Coaches and the library Program Manager.
- Students can visit the <u>Success Coach Corner</u> for study skills, writing resources, and more.
