

Search for a specific form or topic, or click to browse major categories and sample searches.

FINDING LEGAL FORMS

Search

Locate relevant results based on your search term(s). Enter a form category, title, or control number. This is a good place to start when you are looking for a specific form.

Browse Categories

Access organized groupings of forms. This is a great place to start when you want to explore available forms, or don't have a specific form title in mind.

Click one of the **Main Categories** featured on the LegalForms homepage, or use **Browse Categories by Alphabet** to select a letter and view form categories alphabetically. Then choose a subcategory to view available forms related to that topic.

Sample Searches

Perform a search for frequently requested forms just by clicking. Select from links available in the **Sample Searches** tab on the homepage, or choose from the **Most Popular Legal Form Searches** to view relevant available forms organized by category.

WORKING WITH RESULTS

After searching or browsing, view links to relevant forms organized by category. Use the first two letters of each form's control number to identify whether a form applies to multiple states (US) or is state-specific.

If you are working with a large number of results, page through the results or Click to Narrow Search Results.

Click a form's title to access the result.

WORKING WITH FORMS

After accessing a result, read the form description for more information about its use.

Click to download a document in the format of your choice. At a minimum, each form is available as either a Word document or PDF. Some forms also provide a sample completed form for reference. Form packages can be downloaded in entirety, or on a document by document basis, using individual form links.


Once you have opened a downloaded form, print or save the document to your computer or storage device. Many forms can be edited. Documents that cannot may be printed and filled in by hand.
