# **BEST PRACTICES**

#### TRAINING NEEDS ASSESSMENT

- Your Gale Trainer will reach out to schedule a Training Needs Assessment. Use this document to inspire idea creation before your meeting.
  - » This required assessment serves as a critical step in tailoring the training experience to your specific requirements and goals.
  - » Your Trainer will work to understand your instructional objectives and gain insights into areas that need focus and improvement. They will also identify potential challenges and assess learner skill levels to determine the appropriate content and instruction needed.
- It is recommended that you come to the meeting with concrete learning objectives while still remaining open to suggestions from your Trainer.
- Your Trainer will also make recommendations for virtual vs. in person training based on your conversation.
- Know your audience: Understand the needs, interests, and skill levels of your attendees.
  - » Consider pre-assessments or surveys to gather information
- Be realistic about session length: Know how long you will have for this training and choose a session of appropriate length. Work with your Trainer to customize as needed.
- Experience tells us that participants get more out of hands-on training, so we encourage this for all onsite training sessions.
  - » Interactive training require additional time to give your attendees time to work. Your Trainer will suggest possible activities and their time requirements.

#### **SCHEDULING**

- Consider making this a required session: you will have higher attendance and more impactful outcomes.
- Choose the best date and time for all staff: consider already scheduled professional development days.
- Invite all staff: Cast a wide net when inviting staff. Consider librarians, teachers, instructional coaches, and admin.
- Ensure you have appropriate space for all participants. Gale virtual training platform can accommodate
  up to 100 participants. Participant limits for onsite sessions can be assessed during the Training Needs
  Assessment.

#### ATTENDEE PREPAREDNESS AND DAY OF

- Ensure your staff know what type of session they will be attending (virtual or in-person), and where.
- Provide detailed instructions on how to access your resources including URLs and passwords if needed.
- Utilize technology: Have your attendees bring their own devices to get a feel for the resources. This is especially important if you will be doing an interactive activity.
- Check your technology: Verify that projectors, speakers, and internet connection works ahead of time to avoid delays in start time.




