This scavenger hunt will help you navigate the platform to find things like practice tests and resume support.

Click into *Gale Presents: Peterson's Test and Career Prep* to get started, then follow the steps listed below to find your content.

If you don't already have one, create an account using the blue **Log In or Sign Up** button in the banner (the image at the top of the page).

Once signed in, scroll down on the homepage. What options do you see that could be helpful for you?

There are multiple ways to find content within *Gale Presents: Peterson's Test and Career Prep*. First, take a look at the buttons available just below the banner.

What are the six options you can select under this section?

Click into one of the options. Which did you choose? What does the platform tell you to do next?

Follow the directions that appear on each screen until you can access individual entries. Did you find the content you expected in this section? If not, do you think it might be listed under another option found on the homepage? Which one?

For this question, go back to the homepage. Select Title List at the very top of the page.

For this question, go back to the homepage. Scroll down until you see the **Improve Your Test Score** section.

What are the five subcategories you can select under this section?

Click into a subcategory or test that you know you'll need to study for (could be College Prep, AP, ACT, SAT, etc.). Which did you choose? What materials are available to help you study?

Scroll down on the homepage again until you get to the **Vocational Test Prep** section.

Are there any vocations/careers that look interesting to you? Which ones?

Click into the Medical/Nursing section and then select Dental Hygienist Exam Prep. What materials are available for you on this page?

For this question, scroll down to the **Career Tools** section on the homepage.

What are the four subsections found within this section?

What's the difference between the Find a Career and Job Search subsections? (Tip: You're going to have to click into both to find out.)

Now click into the Online Resume Builder. What three things can you make in this tool?

Scroll down to the last section on the homepage, **Find a School or Scholarship**. **Click into the School Search Tool. What are five filters can you use to narrow down the number of schools you see?**

When you click into a school, what information does it provide you with?

One additional way to find content is to search. Go back to the home page and select **Search** at the very top of the page and type a search for a test you need to prep for, or career information. **Did you find the information you were looking for? If not, what is another way you could search for the information?**
